LAURA – Short Presentation of the Chair project:

- ✓ LAURA Chair: an opportunity to permanently transform undergraduate teaching in environmental economics into a multidisciplinary approach to the EU environmental strategies and the Green Deal (GD).
 LAURA activities consist of:
- ✓ A main teaching program at bachelor level including lectures, lab and field experiment classes, dialogic seminars
- ✓ Additional Activities dedicated to discussing the GD at undergraduate level, for the teachers in secondary schools and for the general public
- ✓ Beneficiaries: students of economics (expected number about 100) and students from other fields (e.g., environmental sciences, engineering, etc., about 20), teachers and students at secondary school for 1) above; as for 2) above, target groups are civil servants, public officers and representatives of local governments and institutions; stakeholders, industry, investors, civil society, etc.

- √ improved teaching in environmental economics;
